

STAGE: Dinner Dash Bay

RULES: IDPA Note concealment garment required.
Gun loaded to division capacity.

STARTING POSITION: Sitting at P1, gun loaded and holstered, holding knife and fork, wrists touching table

SCENARIO: While enjoying dinner at a restaurant, you hear shouting, screaming and gunfire. Thugs from the local drug cartel have come to collect a debt from the restaurant owner who happens to be a good friend. Protect your friend and the kitchen staff.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Drop the knife and fork, move to P2, draw and engage T1, T2 and PP1. Move to P3 and engage T3, swinger S1 and T4 in tactical priority. Move to P4 and engage T5 – T7 in tactical priority.

SCORING: Vickers Count

ROUND COUNT: 16 rounds

TARGET DISTANCE: Up to 15 yards

SCORED HITS: Pepper popper until down; one headshot on T5; best two on all other targets

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads behind cover.

START-STOP: Audible & Last shot

SPECIAL NOTES: Shooter must not draw gun until at P2 and facing downrange. T3 should be positioned low, behind wall and can only be engaged from P3 window. No cover calls unless shooter is at a window and engaging targets. T5-T7 should not be seen from P3.

SAFETY ISSUES: Watch for muzzle direction
