

## STAGE: Who Let The Dogs Out? Bay

**RULES:** IDPA Note concealment garment required

**STARTING POSITION:** Standing at P1, hands at side

**SCENARIO:** While walking by a neighbor's yard you notice the gate has been left open. As you approach to close it, two dogs come charging out towards you. You don't have time to close the gate. Get the dogs as they charge and jump at you.

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** At the start signal, engage T1-T4 with one shot each and T5 with two shots. Perform a mandatory reload, then engage T6-T9 with one shot and T10 with two shots.

**SCORING:** Limited Vickers Count

**ROUND COUNT:** 12 rounds

**TARGET DISTANCE:** 1-7 yards

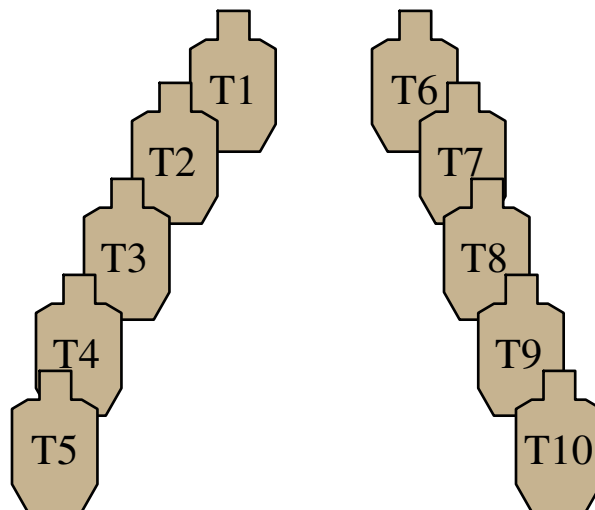
**SCORED HITS:** Best shot on T1-T4 and T6-T9 and best two shots on T5 and T10

**RELOADS:** Any IDPA reloads behind cover.

**START-STOP:** Audible & Last shot

**SPECIAL NOTES:** Zero down circle must be available on all targets. Targets T1-T4 and T6-T9 mount sideways (head facing in to center) and low on sticks, while T5 and T10 are upright with target shoulder at 5 feet.

**SAFETY ISSUES:** Be cautious of muzzle direction and angles on T5 and T10.
